Silk Shibori Poinsettia

Materials needed:

- 1 yard holiday red silk shibori ribbon
- 24" green silk organza ribbon (4 inch)
- 23-30 beads for center (I use miyuki drops)
- 1 magbar or pinback

- needle and thread-
- scissors



The poinsettia can be made in several sizes depending on how long you cut your ribbon pieces but the one we will start with ends up being about 4-4/12".

Start by cutting your red ribbon into the following size pieces:

4 – 4 1/2" pieces

3 - 3" pieces

Cut your green ribbon into 3- 7" inch lengths.

Follow the steps in the videos (each video is about 10 minutes). If you receive this as a PDF download just click the photos to arrive at the videos. Otherwise, copy and past the link into your browser. The videos will take you through the three basic steps to making the poinsettia:

- making the red petals
- making the green leaves
- assembling the petals and leaves.....take your time and enjoy!
